Full Reopening - Monday 8th March

We are very excited to be welcoming our children and families back to school again on Monday 8th March. We understand that this will inspire a range of emotions, and wish to reassure you that we have put in place a significant health and safety plan aimed at protecting our children and staff. - Please ensure **only one member of your household** brings your child(ren) to, and collects them from, school each day.
- Please **remember to wear a facemask or visor** when entering the school, unless you are exempt.
- Drop your child off with us at the hand sanitising stations and then make your way straight to the exit and away from the premises. Your child's class teacher and teaching and learning assistant will be in the playground waiting for your child, to greet them and help them line up.
- We will be checking every child's temperature before they enter the school premises, using an infrared thermometer on their wrist. If a child registers at over 37.8° they must return home immediately and self-isolate until your child has received their test results. [You can order a testing kit here.](#)
- If your child presents with symptoms of Covid-19 (*a new persistent cough, loss of taste or smell or a high temperature*) while at school, we will take the child to our first aid room and a member of our staff will care for them. We will call you immediately and expect you to be with us within 45 minutes of the call. You should then get your child tested as soon as possible and keep them isolated at home for 10 days.
- We will be operating a one-way system - **Pedestrian Gate 1** is our **entrance** and **Pedestrian Gate 2** is our **exit**.
- Please do not enter the school building unless you have made a prior appointment with the school office.** We are happy to help you over the phone or via email.
- Our staff will be testing themselves twice a week, using home lateral flow testing kits. We will inform you immediately if a member of staff in your child's bubble records a positive test result. We would then close that bubble for 10 days, and provide remote learning for your child to engage with on Google Classroom while they self-isolate.

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We are a Lambeth Mental Health Support School



I am delighted to inform you that our school has been selected as a Mental Support Team feeder school. We are one of only six primary schools across Lambeth to have been selected. Our application was recognised for its commitment to the mental health and wellbeing of our children, families and staff and 'that a mentally healthy school ethos is already established in the senior leadership of the school.' This means that:

- ♥ Up to 30 children can be supported by a range of mental health and wellbeing experts – we would work with our parents to identify any needs that may be presented by children at school.
- ♥ We will have one Educational Mental Health Practitioner available on site once a week.
- ♥ We will receive support from an Educational Psychologist for 4 hours a week.
- ♥ We will also receive support from a Child and Adolescent Mental Health Services (CAMHS) practitioner for one day a week, alongside a senior CAMHS Supervisor.

Alongside our Pastoral, Wellbeing and Welfare Officers, Mrs Richmond and Ms Williams, we will be in an even better position to provide the support our children will need after what has been an incredibly challenging year.
