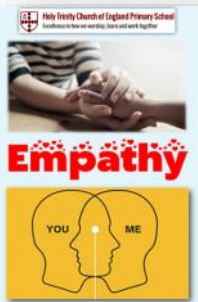
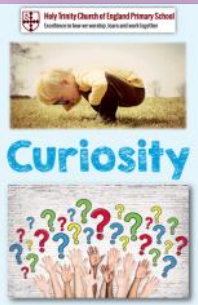
My collective worship theme on Monday is based on the school value of empathy. I will be asking our children to think about things from another person's point of view, and taking care of the environment around us.

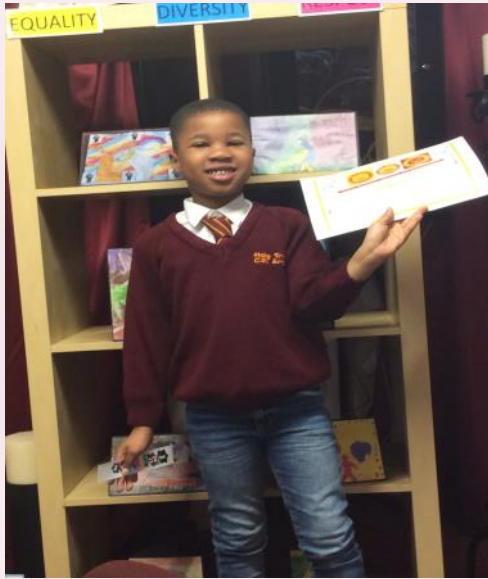

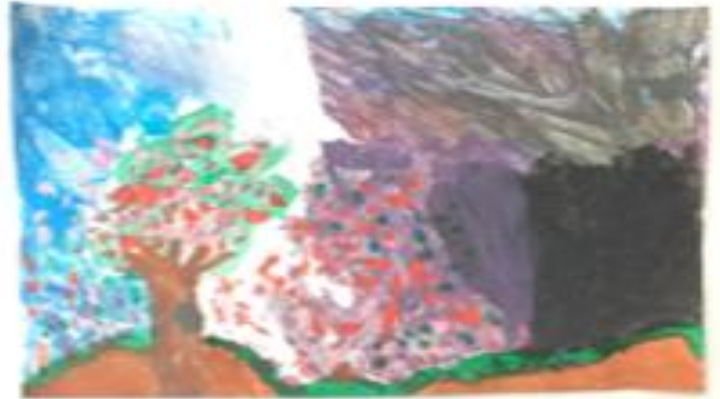

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Online Safety and Technology Newsflash

Internet Searches Precaution

New research by the 5RightsFoundation that inappropriate content is being shown to children who use the internet. Researchers created accounts based on a child, liking and searching for content based on the behaviour of children showing, amongst other things:

- Being targeted for direct messages from adults, including offering adult content.
- Targeting children with age-specific advertising whilst also serving very concerning content (which I can't mention due to email filters).
- Clicking on a dieting tip and then being recommended body distortion content.

Appropriate support and guidance to students is important. Online Safety Bill, the Age Appropriate Design Code or new 'features' built into apps, are not enough.
