
# School Life in September 2021

<u>Government guidance states</u> that life in primary schools can return to relative normality this term. We will continue to adopt a thorough approach towards hygiene and sanitisation throughout our school. However, a number of changes will be in effect from 2<sup>nd</sup> September onwards:

- Our children no longer need to remain in consistent class 'bubbles'.
- Children no longer need to self-isolate if they live in a house with, or a close contact of, someone who tests positive for Covid-19. Instead, they will be contacted by NHS Test and Trace, informed they have been in close contact with a positive case and advised to take a PCR test. We would encourage all individuals to take a PCR test if advised to do so.
- Staggered school start and end times are no longer advised.
- Face coverings are no longer advised in and around the school premises. If you enter our school building, however, we would appreciate you wearing a face covering for the protection of both yourself and our school community.

## Start of School Day

- Staggered timings will cease. All children will start at 8.45am, as of 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2021.
- The school gates will open at 8.40am every morning.
- Any non-class based support staff and SLT will continue to be present in the front playground at the start and end of the school day.
- All teaching and support staff will meet the children and parents at the start and end of the day. Staff will arrive at 8.40am arrival in the front playground.
- **Year 2** will line up directly outside their classroom doors.
- \* Reception will line up adjacent to the Maddox Centre, to walk down the staircase into their playground.
- ❖ Year 1, 3 and 4 will line up in the bottom half of the playground (nearest school building), walking down the middle staircase and either through the hall or to the left of the school office.
- ❖ Year 5 & 6 will line up in the top half of the playground (nearest Upper Tulse Hill), following the same route into the school building as Years 1, 3 & 4.
- Classes will leave the playground one at a time, calmly and quietly, in year group order.
- The school gate will close at 9am every morning.

### End of School Day

- All children will end the school day at 3.15pm, as of 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2021.
- Class teachers and support staff will lead the children to the same position in the front playground as they began the day.
- Every parent, carer or family member must request the collection of their child from the class teacher, face to face, before the child is safely handed over.
- Reception children will be collected by their parents and carers from their classroom in the Autumn Term.

#### Parent Pay and Payments

This year Holy Trinity will be adopting a strict policy towards payments for music tuition and school trips. This is due to our school losing a significant amount of money through non-payment of fees last year. As of 2<sup>nd</sup> September, we will be requesting the full amount for music tuition and school trips before any tuition or trips can take place for your child. These payments should be made through the usual method of ParentPay.

Ms Ansah will be writing to you with details of this year's music offer through Lambeth Music Service. Children eligible as Pupil Premium will be offered a 50% subsidy for all tuition. Payment must be made by 20<sup>th</sup> September for the term's tuition sessions.

I request your support in ensuring the school no longer loses money due to non-payment of fees for school dinners, music tuition and school trips. Thank you.
