




What do you think makes a Christian?

I grew up in a church that had a very clear view of what a "true Christian" was. All you had to do was to say a specific prayer, and that was that.

I remember someone describing some friends, "They're Catholics," she said, "but they are actually Christians as well." It was a genuine revelation (shared only by the "very mature!") that people of other faith styles could actually be Christians also.

Although we believed that - in truth - only the Lord knows the secrets of our hearts, we did have a number of marks by which we could judge if someone had what we considered to be a "genuine faith." Did they have a testimony of how they were converted? Did they sing in church with their eyes shut? Did they tell you they would pray for you? Did they keep a Bible by their bed, or in their living room - and did it look as if they read it? Did they claim Bible promises for their own life? Did they remind you that it was true? Did they speak about the Lord?

These were all ways by which we thought we knew who was a "true Christian." But Jesus never used any of these "marks" to distinguish between people. To think that they are true indicators of someone's faith - or more importantly, that the lack of them shows a lack of true faith - is naïve, foolish and dangerous. Jesus only called for one thing: "Will you follow me and do God's will?"

Of course, none of us ever does God's will completely. But if we're honest, if we are trying to follow Jesus, if we genuinely attempt to do what God wants, then really, that's all that matters.

Jesus makes quite serious demands of his followers, but he is also incredibly inclusive. I pray that we will, like Jesus practice a generous and inclusive faith.

What parents and carers need to know about setting up new devices for children

Some adults shy away from adjusting the parental controls on their child's digital devices, assuming that they'll be hard to understand and tricky to set up. In most cases, however, it's refreshingly straightforward: just a few clicks of a mouse or touches of a screen can provide an extra layer of protection for children using those devices to explore the online world.

From restricting inappropriate content and blocking in-app purchases to setting automatic screen-time limits and restricting who can contact your child online, this guide has some useful tips. It will show you how to set up devices so that when your child uses them to go online, you can be more confident about their safety.

YOUTHSAYERS

If you are a young person with some experience of playing a musical instrument and would like to play with a band made up of like minded young people, this opportunity is for you.

Youthsayers run weekly, free of charge sessions in Brixton and West Norwood.

We work with various genres, but mainly focus on afrobeat, jazz and reggae.

The project will offer you a chance to learn about group playing, improvisation, arranging, directing a band and most of all, have fun with music.

Youthsayers is a performing group and we have played lots of great gigs in venues like The Royal Albert Hall, Rich Mix, Lambeth Country Show, Trafalgar Square, Womad Festival, Freedom Sounds Festival in Cologne Germany etc.

We are not looking for people with any set standard, but we really value a positive attitude and young people that want to be part of a mutually supportive group. Also an interest playing afrobeat, jazz and reggae would be good but, if this music is new to you, that's fine.

We run 2 groups. The age range for the groups is 9yrs to 13yrs and then 13yrs to 20yrs.



Currently, both groups are full because we have restrictions on numbers due to Covid 19 rules.

Many tutors maintain active links to the music industry and all are specialists on their chosen instruments.

These introductory group courses for beginners allow learners to explore different instruments belonging to their chosen pathway before going on to secure key technical skills on a single instrument.

Learners can explore instruments such as the **TRUMPET** and **TROMBONE** on the Brass Pathway, **FLUTE** and **CLARINET** in the Woodwind Pathway, **DRUMS** and **TUNED PERCUSSION** as part of the Percussion Pathway and **VIOLIN** and **CELLO** in the String Pathway.

We also provide pathways for **KEYBOARDS, GUITARS** and **VOICE**.
