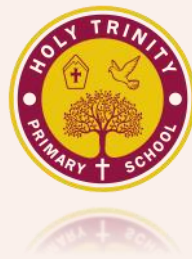

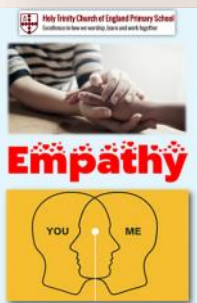
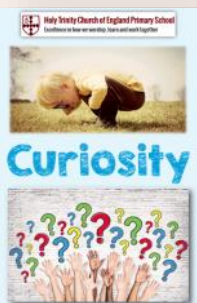

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Online Safety and Technology Newsflash

Are your children getting their news from Tik-Tok?

Unlike many adults, most children and young people don't get their news from reputable sites. They are more likely to get their news from social media and YouTube.

Sadly, much of this is fake, false or misleading but appears to be real, including scenarios recorded in the popular game Call of Duty and uploaded to appear as though it actually happened.

Talks with children and young people need to be topical and they need to understand the facts in relation to what they are likely to use, e.g. TikTok.

Doing so will give you a much higher likelihood that they will understand what you are saying, relate it to their own online experiences, and therefore the chance of a positive impact is much greater.
