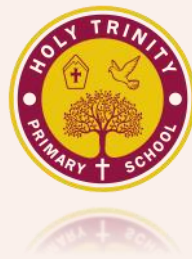

Dear Holy Trinity Community,

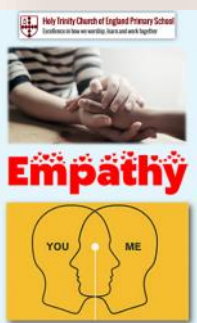
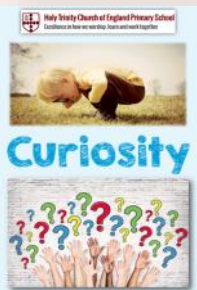
