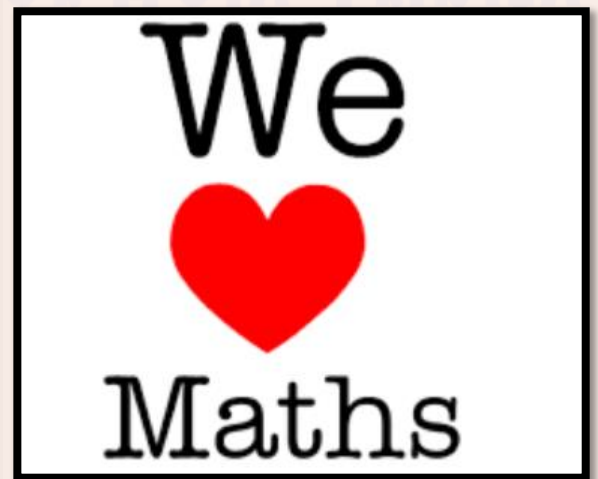
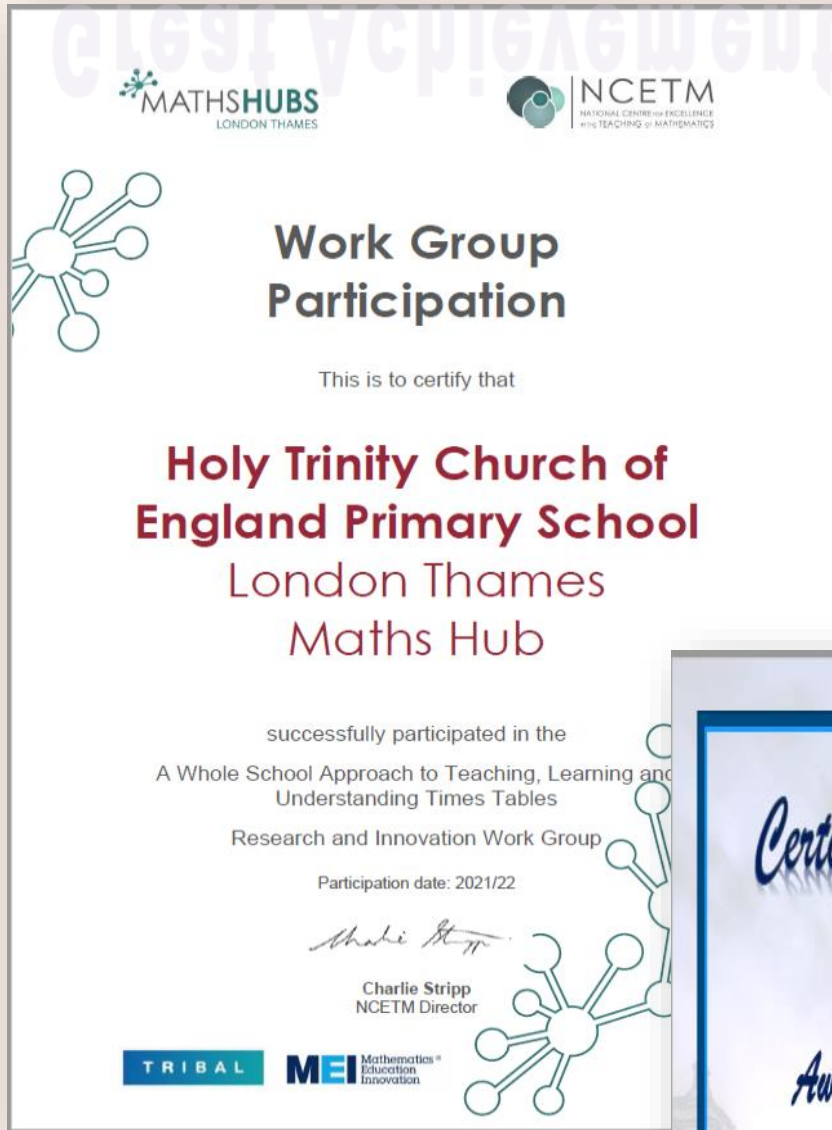
We are grateful for every opportunity you have given us to glorify you in our work and in our play. We praise you Father for guiding and protecting us along the way especially when challenges have arisen.

## How to Set Up Gaming Consoles to Prevent Impulse Purchases

You will be aware that it is too easy for children and young people to purchase virtual items in games and apps. Some of the amounts that primary school children are spending is eye-watering. Another problem can be accidental purchasing, where the game has used 'nudge' techniques to entice a purchase.

Many devices have parental controls which can help to mitigate these purchases. Wayne Denner from Ireland has put together a short article which some parents will find useful, detailing how to set up parental controls on popular devices including the Play Station, iPhone and Xbox.
