


#### **Dear Holy Trinity Community**,

Welcome to our last edition of Newsdesk for the 2021-22 academic year. Where has the time gone? The year has absolutely flown by.






You will have received my end of year letter this morning with some very important updates, including your child's class and staff names for next year. It looks set to be another excellent year at Holy Trinity.






We are grateful for every opportunity you have given us to glorify you in our work and in our play. We praise you Father for guiding and protecting us along the way especially when challenges have arisen.

- Fun physical activity sessions




- A wide range of other activities to suit different ages and personalities
