
Important Notices

- ◆ School Uniform - all old school uniform items (with the previous school logo on) should no longer be worn to school as of September 5th 2022. All school uniform is now only available at School Uniform Direct. [Please click here](#) - early bird discounts are available now!
- ◆ School meal prices - due to a significant increase in labour and delivery charges, we have no choice but to increase our school dinner prices to £2.50p per day for children in Years 3 – 6. This price is still comparatively low in relation to nearby schools in the borough.
- ◆ Wraparound care prices - in order to ensure our school does not lose money in providing before and after school care for our children, we must increase our prices. Breakfast Club will now cost £5 per day, and After School Activity Club will now cost £9 per day. The changes to prices will come into effect on Monday 5th September.
- ◆ Some exciting news! Our front playground will be resurfaced and new perimeter fencing installed over the summer holiday, with exciting new playground markings that will help our children keep fit and healthy, whilst having lots of fun. This work is set to be completed by the last week of the summer holiday, ready for your return in September.

Thank you for your ongoing support of our school this year. We have made great strides in a range of different aspects, from the PTFA's successful events, improvements to our physical and natural environment, music, arts and sports achievements through to even better collaboration and involvement with our parents. We continue to grow together as one Holy Trinity family.
