Jeans for Genes works with schools, companies and individuals all over the UK to help services and support for the children and their families affected by genetic conditions. Together, through fund and awareness raising, we can help make a real difference to their lives.

All children and staff are invited to wear their jeans on **Friday, 23rd of September.** We would really love to see as many classes and students as possible in their jeans, so please encourage your child to come into school on the day wearing their jeans and with their £1 donation.

The theme this year is 'How do you wear yours?' and is an opportunity for children to wear their perfect partner to their jeans – be it a white tee shirt, their favourite movie or band tee shirt, favourite sports jersey, bunny ears, trainers – whatever their favourite beloved item of clothing or accessory is, we would love to see them!
