Our staff have had two very productive INSET Days this week. On Tuesday we came together with the other nine Windmill Cluster Schools to develop our understanding of working with children with special educational needs. It was an inspirational day and we took much key learning from it. On Wednesday our staff completed first aid training, and positive behaviour support training in order to be able to care for children in crisis, whenever that may arise.

There was a lovely buzz around the school as the children returned to us this week. It was great to see their smiling faces as they arrived in the morning, and it is clear many of you had enjoyable holidays. We aim to keep this momentum and positivity going as we get settled in to our learning this half-term. The new term brings with it lots to look forward to, and our children begin their new curriculum topics around the pathway 'In the beginning...' – with a particular focus on our environment and the impact of climate change.

- ❖ Ms Linda Williams and I will be closely monitoring the punctuality and attendance of our children this term. Our whole school target is 96% - we currently stand at 94.7%.
- ❖ Our school is a 'Greet Your Child With a Smile, Not a Mobile' zone – please ensure your phonecall is completed when you arrive at the school gates. Your child will be very excited to see you and share the news from their day at school. Our Senior Leadership Team will be requesting that you put your phones and devices away as you enter the school gates.
