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








Dear Parents/Carers,

'I think there are many ways we can make sure that there is peace in school, like not messing around, walking around calmly, saying kind things to each other and saying please and thank you.'




'I think being cheerful and helping others is a way of keeping a peaceful atmosphere in school.'

The children identified a number of next steps and they will be conducting a series of monitoring tasks over the next few weeks.




